Dear Parents and Carers,

Tour de Yorkshire - Thursday 2nd May

The Tour de Yorkshire will be going through Little Weighton once again this year. The men's race is due to pass through at 3.31pm. As this time is quite near the end of the day we have decided not to take the children to watch this event. At an event such as this, it is quite difficult to supervise and entertain the children, whilst ensuring their safety. However we appreciate that this may be something parents want to share with their children. If you would like to collect your child/(ren) at **2.30pm** to watch the men's race, please complete the attached slip at the end of the letter.

The Tour de Yorkshire may also cause some disruption to roads, so if you are travelling from outside of the village this may be something to be aware of, especially at school pick-up time.

The Friends of the School are hoping to have a refreshment stand on the green - so if you do go to spectate please help our school by supporting the refreshment stand.

We will however, be having a 'Tour de Yorkshire' afternoon in school with the children taking part in some sport related activities. We are keen to have mini 'Tour de Little Weighton School' involving the children doing laps of the school on scooters. If your child has a scooter and is willing to lend this to other children, please can you send it into school on the day of the Tour de Yorkshire (please can you make sure they are labelled so that all scooters get returned to the right owner). Children can come to school in their uniforms as usual and change into their PE kits in the afternoon.

Summer Days

Water - if your child wishes, they may bring a named bottle of **water** into school that can be kept in the classroom and taken home on a daily basis. Please can you also send a sun hat/cap to school for your child, if possible one that can be kept in school for the summer term.

Sun Cream - please can parents either apply sun-cream to their children at home before school or send their children to school with sun-cream in a labelled bottle. Please can you show your child how to put sun-cream on and have a little chat about not sharing it with friends. We've got a few children who are allergic to some sun-creams.
