## Covid Guidance

The Covid guidance continues to change on a regular basis and sometimes differs depending on the source. Below is the guidance from EYRC...

### All educational establishments

*From 24 February 2022, the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. However, both adults and children who test positive are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days. On the fifth and sixth day, if negative test results are returned, the individual can cease staying at home and return to normal activity (i.e., return to school). However, if they do not return negative test results on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> day, they should be strongly advised to continue to stay at home until they have returned 2 negative results. Regardless of test results, they can return to school on the 11<sup>th</sup> day.*

We will continue to follow this guidance and ask for your co-operation in continuing to ensure we protect the more vulnerable members of our community.

## Red Nose Day - Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March

For Red Nose Day this year, we will be having a non-uniform day and a bun sale. We would really appreciate donations of buns, but we don't want to waste any (or eat too many!). So please could the children in **Class 2** bring in some buns (6 buns per child is plenty). If your child wishes to wear their non-uniform and eat a bun, please can they bring in a £1 donation.

## PE Sessions
