Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been an interesting few weeks... but the sun is shinning and we seem to be over the worst of our 'Covid outbreak'. Many thanks for all your support in following the East Riding's recommended guidance. I have included this below as we will no doubt continue to have cases in the community but hopefully not as many at once as we have had during the last few weeks. We can now allow visitors back into school and we have rescheduled the cancelled film night to next Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> March. If your child would like to attend, please sign up on SIMs pay. Any payments already made will be carried forward.

#### All educational establishments

From 24 February 2022, the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. However, both adults and children who test positive are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days. On the fifth and sixth day, if negative test results are returned, the individual can cease staying at home and return to normal activity (i.e., return to school). However, if they do not return negative test results on the  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  day, they should be strongly advised to continue to stay at home until they have returned 2 negative results. Regardless of test results, they can return to school on the  $11^{th}$  day.

#### New Telephone System

We have a new telephone system in school with a facility where you can report child absence. Please press 'option one' to leave a message. The office phone is manned between 8.30am and 4.00pm and Mrs Waterhouse regularly checks the answer machine throughout the school day. If your child is going home with someone else, or someone who doesn't usually pick up (e.g. someone not on your contact list or not a friend or grandparent) please let Mrs Atkinson know as you drop off in the morning. If this changes during the school day please **telephone** or **email** the school office (rather than text the school phone, as sometimes these messages don't come through and sometimes the mobile is on my desk and I don't see the messages until I've finished teaching!).

#### Safety Around the School Site

I have received a complaint from a parent about a small number of parents who are dropping their children off on the zig-zag lines. Please can I remind you that parking or stopping on the yellow zig-zag lines is strictly prohibited. This is to ensure the safety of all members of the school community.

Please can I also ask that anyone visiting the site uses the school path to enter and exit the school ground. As Covid restrictions are easing, I think it would be safer for everyone to return to using the path to enter and exit the site (rather than having a one-way system). The school driveway is in constant use and we do sometimes have delivery drivers who seem to forget that there may be children around! Can I also ask that all parents/carers who are collecting children from Foundation Stage or Class 1 enter the school grounds to collect their child (either stood on the path, or in the playground). If for any reason you are unable to do this, please arrange for another adult to escort your child to you safely.

#### Red Nose Day

The children enjoyed Red Nose Day and we managed to raise £38 The children enjoyed the buns (thank you Class 2 and Mrs Clayton's daughter for making and donating them). The children took part in a "red nose' themed orienteering course.
