#### Illness in School

COVID-19 is circulating in our community and we would like your support in being vigilant to your child developing any symptoms.

Symptoms of COVID-19, flu and common respiratory infections include:

- continuous cough
- high temperature, fever or chills
- loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell
- shortness of breath
- unexplained tiredness, lack of energy
- muscle aches or pains that are not due to exercise
- not wanting to eat or not feeling hungry
- headache that is unusual or longer lasting than usual

- sore throat, stuffy or runny nose
- diarrhoea, feeling sick or being sick

For children and young people aged 18 and under who test positive for COVID-19, the advice is to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.
